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Language Proficiency Agreement Form

I _____, born on (d/m/y) _____, declare that within one (1) year of landing in Canada, I will provide proof to Island Investment Development Inc. that I have attained a moderate level of proficiency in speaking, reading, writing and listening in English and/or French.

In support of this undertaking, I have pledged a deposit of \$20,000 Canadian dollars be held by the Province of Prince Edward Island for a maximum of one (1) year after I am granted permanent resident status by the Government of Canada. The deposit is fully refundable, without interest, provided, that I am able to provide evidence satisfactory to the Province of Prince Edward Island that I have attained a moderate level of proficiency in speaking, reading, writing, and listening in English and/or French.

Moderate Proficiency (Stage I - CLB Levels 3-4)

The range of abilities needed to communicate in common and predictable settings to meet basic needs and to carry out everyday activity. A curriculum aligned to the Benchmarks and targeting the language proficiencies of stage 1 learners would focus on topics of immediate personal relevance.

Conditions Precedent to Refund of the Language Proficiency Deposit Pledged by an Immigrant

1. To provide proof of attaining a certificate stating the Principal Applicant has attained a minimum of in Canadian Language Benchmark of Level 3, in all four skills, speaking, listening, reading, and writing. The certificate and testing must be done at an accredited facility in Prince Edward Island
2. To provide proof of having maintained a residence in Prince Edward Island for a minimum period of one (1) year. Copies of rental agreement, property tax, utility bills, school registration and community involvement, bank statements, letter from an employer, are some of the documents that may be requested.

Within one (1) year of the date of landing, the Provincial Nominee must contact the Province of Prince Edward Island to set up an interview to prove that the conditions precedent to refund have been met. In the event that the applicant fails to notify the Province of Prince Edward Island, before the one (1) year anniversary date of landing, the deposit will be forfeited.
